

NP-PHP Connector Route No. 2. (East to West) 12-10-20

1. From the North Nickel Plate trailhead in Rochester, leave the trail and follow the cross road, Mitchell Drive west. After a couple of turns, Mitchell Drive changes into 18th St.
2. Continue ahead (west) on 18th Street to the traffic light. After this traffic light 18th St. is also Indiana State Road 14. Caution: High speed traffic.
3. Continue ahead (west) on 18th St. /S.R. 14 to and over the U.S. Hwy 31 overpass.
4. Once on the other side of the overpass, turn left (south) onto Meridian Road.
5. Follow Meridian Road south about 1 mile to Fulton County Road 100 S.
6. Turn right (west) at County Road 100 S. and proceed west to C.R. 850 W.
7. Turn left (south) at C.R. 850 W. and go south about 1.5 miles to the “T” at C.R. 250 S.
8. Turn right (west) onto C.R. 250 S. and proceed west to and through the small town of Kewanna. C.R. 250 S. is Main St. Kewanna is about 15.5 miles from the Nickel Plate.
9. Continue ahead (west) on C.R. 250 S. several more miles. After an “S” curve, C.R. 250 S. turns into C.R. 225 S.
10. Continue west on C.R. 225 S. to C.R. 225 E.
11. Turn right (north) onto C.R. 225 E. and go a quarter of a mile north to C.R. 200 S.
12. Turn left (west) and go west on C.R. 200 S. to the “T” at U.S. 35 Hwy. Caution: High speed traffic.
13. Carefully crossover U.S. 35 Hwy and turn left (south) and go about 200 feet.
14. Turn right into a short, paved driveway.
15. Welcome. You have arrived at The Panhandle Pathway.
16. Turn right and proceed north approximately 2 miles to Winamac, IN.
17. Turn left and proceed south to Star City, Thornhope, Royal Center or Kenneth, the present south terminus of the Panhandle Pathway.
