

Going North from Winamac to the North Judson Erie Trail

1. You are beginning a 13 mile over the road connector route to the North Judson Erie trail in Starke County. This route uses public roads shared with motorized vehicles. Please use caution and follow all highway rules of the road. Have a safe and enjoyable trip.
2. Starting at mile marker 00.0 at the Winamac depot near Main & Logan Streets, travel west on Main St., up the steep hill, past the cemetery to the “T” at Pulaski County Road 60 W.
3. Turn right on County Road 60 W and proceed north to County Road 25 S.
4. Turn left on C.R. 25 S and proceed west to the “T” at C.R. 100 W.
5. Turn right onto C.R. 100 W and proceed north across IN State Road 14 (caution: High speed traffic), to the “T” at C.R. 200 N.
6. Turn left onto C.R. 200 N and proceed west to C.R. 300 W.
7. Turn right on C.R. 300 W and proceed north through the small community of Ripley to C.R. 900 S. Note: C.R. 900 S is the Pulaski-Starke County line and a time change to Central Time.
8. Turn right and go east a short distance of about 100 feet and then turn left (north) onto Starke County Road 200 E.
9. Proceed on ahead (north) on C.R. 200 E to the North Judson Erie trail crossing.
10. Welcome. You have arrived at the North Judson Erie Trail.
11. Turn right and travel east to U.S. 35 Hwy and the Bass Lake Station trailhead.
12. Turn left and travel west to IN State Road 10, the rest park, the town of North Judson and the Hoosier Valley Railroad Museum.
