






Trail Map

to Logansport ---

The Panhandle Pathway is a hiking/ biking trail stretching 22 miles through north-central Indiana, between Winamac and France Park. The Pathway follows the old railbed of the Pennsylvania Railroad line southward across the Tippecanoe River and Mill Creek, through Star City, Thornhope, and Royal Center, then on to Kenneth, which is located west of Logansport.







PATHWAY TRAILHEADS

A trailhead is a place where a trail begins, or an access point to the trail. The trailheads listed below all have parking.

DEPOT TRAILHEAD

Winamac Parkway Located at west corner of Logan and Main streets. From US 35 turn west at the courthouse on Main St. and

WINAMAC TRAILHEAD (north end)

proceed west for 2 blocks.

Pulaski County

From US 35 at the south edge of Winamac travel south to County Road (Cty Rd) 150 S, then turn west. Trailhead and parking are immediately on the south side of Cty Rd 150 S.

STAR CITY TRAILHEAD

Pulaski County

At Star City, from US 35, turn south onto Cty Rd 250 E then west on Key St. Follow Key St. west to the corner of Key and Railroad streets. Parking is on the west side of the trailhead off of Railroad St.

ROYAL CENTER TRAILHEAD

Cass County

From US 35 N on the south side of Royal Center, turn west onto Kramer St. (across from Pioneer School Administration Building) Trailhead and parking are west of the corner of Kramer St. and the Panhandle Pathway.

KENNETH TRAILHEAD (south end)

Cass County

Travel US 24 west of Logansport past France Park to Cass Cty Rd 600 W. Turn north and proceed on 600 W to the first stop sign. Turn right and proceed east on 50 N approximately ½ mile. The trailhead is on the left.
